Scenario #1	<p>Patient must meet at least one of the following Moderately or Severely Immunocompromised Criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Acute treatment for solid tumor and hematologic malignancies• Receipt of solid-organ transplant and taking immunosuppressive therapy• Receipt of CAR-T-cell or hematopoietic stem cell transplant (within 2 years of transplantation or taking immunosuppression therapy)• Moderate or severe primary immunodeficiency (e.g., DiGeorge, Wiskott-Aldrich syndromes)• Advanced or untreated HIV infection• Active treatment with high-dose corticosteroids (<i>i.e.</i>, ≥ 20mg prednisone or equivalent per day), alkylating agents, antimetabolites, transplant-related immunosuppressive drugs, cancer chemotherapeutic agents classified as severely immunosuppressive, TNF blockers, and other biologic agents that are immunosuppressive or immunomodulatory• Chronic conditions associated with varying degrees of immune deficit, such as asplenia, sickle cell and chronic renal disease.• Other diagnosed chronic condition with equivalent moderate to severe level of immunocompromised	YES	<input type="checkbox"/>
